## **Publications**

The EEC released new summary reports of investigations by the Offices of the Executive Inspectors General (EIG). According to the Ethics Act, an EIG is required to issue a summary report when, after the investigation, the EIG

determines that reasonable cause exists to believe a violation has occurred. The Ethics Act requires that some summary reports be made available to the public and authorizes the EEC to release others. Before making the reports available, however, the EEC redacts information that may reveal the identity of witnesses, complainants, informants, or other investigation-related information. In releasing the reports, the EEC neither makes nor adopts any determination of fact or conclusions of law for or against any individual or entity referenced in the reports. ## Statements of Economic Interest (SEI) & Supplemental Statements of Economic Interest (SSEI)



The deadline for filing Statements of Economic Interest (SEI) and Supplemental Statements of Economic Interest (SSEI) forms is fast approaching. Under the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act and Executive Order 15-09, the forms are to be **filed on or before May 1, 2025**. SEIs are filed with the Secretary of State and guidance on completing the form is available [here](#).
